

3.18 Equipment Asset Tax

Overview

Many times customers in the United States are required to pay personal property taxes. This is usually thought of as land and buildings but regularly includes vehicles and equipment. This is most often imposed as a local or state tax. Use the setup procedure below to establish the setup codes and apply them to customer records.

Asset Tax Setup

The *Asset Tax Code* is used to identify the location of each piece of equipment on a pre-determined date.

The asset tax code is established in *Lists > Accounting Setup*. The setup screen is shown below.



The two fields on the graphic below are to only provide the code identification and the local geographic area covered by this code. Each customer will be assigned an asset tax code on the *Route* tab of the Customer *Information* screen.

Fields:


ID: Enter up to two characters that will represent the *Asset Tax Code*.

Description: Enter a description for the Asset Tax Code. This is usually the description of the geographic area levying the tax.



Customer Information

The required *Asset Tax Code* is assigned as shown in the right center of the screen below. Select the appropriate code from the drop down menu of asset tax codes made in the graphic above.




Asset Tax Codes are not normally assigned to a piece of equipment because equipment can be moved to different taxing jurisdictions. Equipment valuation is established under Lists > Equipment > Equipment Master List.



Reports

The *Asset Tax Report* is provided by ARS so the location of each piece of equipment subject taxation is properly identified. The equipment owned by your company is subject to this taxation.

Note the exclusions for equipment with *Period Codes* 2 and 3. *Period Code* 2 is for special rental agreements. *Period Code* 3 is for sold equipment. If special help is needed in this area, contact Advantage Route Systems.



Summary
